Assessment	Initial Follow-up
Personal and family medical history	Initially
Child/teen behavior	Each visit
Sedation/somnolence	Each visit
Sexual/reproductive dysfunction	During titration, then every 2 months
Parkinsonism, akathisia	During titration, then every 2 months
Weight, weight gain	Each visit
Blood pressure and pulse	At 1 month and annually
Eye/teeth, dental records, chest and skin findings	Annually
Feeding (food, glucose and lipids)	At 1 month, then every 2 months
Drug/toxicology tests	At 1 month, then annually
Proctitis	Only if symptomatic
ECG	Only if taking ziprasidone
